Title **ADVANCED STEM CELL TECHNOLOGY**

Description: A laboratory intensive course focused on the technical aspects of human embryonic stem cell technology. Develops specific technical skills to successfully culture, characterize and maintain pluripotent human embryonic stem cell lines

This course is being offered as a stand-alone workshop by University of Southern California (USC) for our MS Biotech students enrolled in the Stem Cell Technology and Lab Management emphasis. Funding (training course fee) for this workshop is provided by the California Institute for Regenerative Medicine (CIRM) directly to USC and students are neither required to pay tuition for this workshop nor receive any academic credit.
