Proposed Name of Minor: Anthropology

1. Catalog Description The Minor in Anthropology provides students with an introduction to the four fields of anthropology: cultural anthropology, bioanthropology, archaeology, and linguistics.
2. Justification for Proposed Minor (< 100 words) Substantial coursework is offered in Anthropology at every community college in the CSUCI service area, so students should be offered an opportunity to continue their studies in Anthropology. Anthropology offers a nexus of interdisciplinary training. All courses required for the minor meet General Education requirements, with several meeting Liberal Studies Teaching and Learning Option as well.
