JUSTIFICATION

The original Long Form for the MBA states that “a grade of ‘C’ or better is required to meet the criteria,” but this line is in the subsection marked “Foundations of Business,” rather than the section heading “The MBA Curriculum.” This is an oversight on our part, which we seek to remedy here. That is, this is only a change in the catalog, not in our intended policy.
