A. Justification:

MOU's between CI and several partner international universities (such as Zeppelin University in Germany) necessitate CI establish this course for credit accounting. These MOUs state that the receiving institution shall waive all tuition costs for incoming students of the partner school. Outgoing students will pay tuition to their home institutions before departure. (Room, board, transportation, travel documents, books and other expenses are not covered by the receiving institution.) Therefore, CI students attending a partner campus will pay fees to CI.

Consequently the placeholder course REGISTRN 399 entitled "Registration – Detached Enrollment" will need to be replaced by the proposed Study Abroad Courses – this IPSA - in order to keep the unit/fees correct as well as show the specific course topics the student took. If the MOU indicates the work taken abroad is to be counted as resident coursework, the system will only be able to manage this as a regularly scheduled course (*with additional course sections for each course topic.*)
