#### INFORMATIONAL AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

- Language requirements. Antonio Jimenez.
  - Pre-arrival discussion
  - What about the HS biliteracy seal? Is that required to count for such a requirement?
    - Negative. Some ways to get the seal count for college credit, others don't.
    - Some colleges are already deciding to take the seal as evidence of language proficiency, others are not.
    - Questions Curriculum has on proposal:
      - Lots of students are getting the HS bilteracy seal based on college creditattached classes. What about non-college credit paths to the seal?
      - For someone who's already proficient in two languages, should that count for college credit, in effect?
      - How many students would actually have to take 3 more units under this policy?
  - o Actual presentation & discussion
    - This is part of the original mission of the college; somehow it got lost.
    - Tried to increase it in the past; that doesn't work for large-unit majors, who were not keen on the increase.
    - This proposal is a compromise: it's only for \*BA\* students, not for BS students.
    - Proposal includes the effect on BA students
      - Note: these calculations don't hold for Transfer Model Curricula (Art, ECS, and English). We need to account for that.
    - One idea to "fit" the proposal into the curriculum: modifying area C unit counts, so both intro language classes (101 & 102) fulfill separate pieces.
    - Are there resource requirements for assessing language competency?
      - Other than the "other" category, no—the rest just require the presentation of outside-affirmed competency.
    - What about languages for which there are none of these outside methods of assessing proficiency?
      - That's the point of the final "or other method by department" bullet.
    - Additional suggested bullet: Defense Language Institute certification.
    - Concern: having a non-uniform graduation requirement (or, rather, having \*another\* non-uniform graduation requirement).
    - More on resources: How many more 102-level courses do we need?
      - Unsure, but there will be more, and that is partially the point of the requirement—to grow the second courses for those that are interested.
    - This could not be implemented next year, but perhaps in two years?

- It will require planning if it is adopted.
- Also need to talk to the community colleges too, so they can start planning (and advising their students accordingly).
- More on "fitting in" the language requirement: could C3b or C3c be waived for those who take both semesters of language here on campus?
  - Many solutions for Area C that would not be unit-increasing for students were discussed. Among them were making area C more like community colleges.
  - Also: What other program is this going to impact?
