 - h. Would be good to fix the APC process alongside fixing the master plan.

 - a. Coherence are there themes/clusters of courses? How well do courses align with themes/student learning outcomes? Do the classes proceed logically?
 - b. Clarity is the program easy to understand? Could a student read the description of the major and follow the sequence of courses?
 - c. Assessment how and when will evaluation occur? How will data be used?
