- Elimination of the requirement to take SPAN 301 and SPAN 302 for the minor.
- Addition of the course SPAN 320 INTRODUCTION TO SPANISH TRANSLATION (3)

## **JUSTIFICATION**

The elimination of the requirement to take SPAN 301 and SPAN 302 will allow more flexibility for those students who come to the minor with a high proficiency in Spanish. In this case, with the consent of the Spanish faculty, these students can focus on other content areas, such as culture, literature, art, history, Spanish for careers, or translation.

The addition of the course "Introduction to Spanish Translation" responds to the increasing need of translations from Spanish to English and vice versa motivated by the high number of monolingual speakers of Spanish in the county.
