In this case, with the consent of the Spanish faculty, these students can focus on other content areas, such as culture, literature, art, history, Spanish for careers, or translation.
The addition of the course "Introduction to Spanish Translation" responds to the increasing need of translations from Spanish to English and vice versa motivated by the high number of monolingual speakers of Spanish in the county.
