Guidelines for placing programs on the Master Plan:

- 1. A balanced curriculum across the social and behavioral sciences, arts, humanities, sciences, business, education, and professional programs.
- 2. Programs which address the expected student characteristics
- 3. Programs which support the university's mission statement, particularly in terms of interdisciplinarity, multiculturalism, innovation, and uniqueness
- 4. Cost of the program
- 5. Is the learning infrastructure in place to support the program (library, labs, etc.)?
- 6. A balance among undergraduate and graduate programs
- 7. Programs which support local infrastructure and community needs
- 8. Programs where the university has hired or intends to hire faculty
- 9. Priority in terms of immediate and long-term need
- 10. CSU systemwide distribution of programs
