Description: A critical examination of classical and contemporary research across the range of subfields in Sociology. Focuses on logic and processes of social research while exploring central questions and issues in the discipline.

The Sociology Program faculty proposed this course with the idea that it would serve as an “advanced introduction to sociology” course that would help level the playing field between our transfer and native students. We have decided that another course (that we already require of our majors and minors), Social Stratification, would better serve this purpose. For this reason, we no longer need SOC 302 Survey of Sociological Research as part of our program.
