

**Inventory of SRSC Initiatives**  
(In-Progress and Proposed)

1. Funding for student travel to conferences.
  - A. Up to \$500 per student funding for students attending disciplinary regional or national research conferences.
  - B. Complete funding for students presenting the Southern California Council for Undergraduate Research.
  - C. Complete funding for students presenting at the CSU Student Research Competition.
  - D. SRSC funding may be used to support students attending a conference but not presenting, if excess funding is available.
  - E. Assist OSR with Sage Research Forum
  - F. Last AY, \$56,000.00 allocated directly to over 150 students for Student Research conferences.
2. Student Undergraduate Research Fellows (SURFers)
  - A. Freshman Living Learning Community. Students take three linked courses during the Fall and three during the spring. Students are housed on campus together. Conducted in conjunction with Student Affairs. **In progress AY 2015-2016.**
  - B. Transfer Student Learning Community. Students take one or more courses focused on conducting faculty-mentored research. **In development.**
  - C. Interdisciplinary Research Learning Community. Continuing students are nominated by faculty and selected by the SRSC. Students receive a stipend and travel funding to attend a conference. Students earn one credit by enrolling in UNIV 311. **Taught Spring 2015. Planned for Spring 2016.**

3. Support for faculty-initiated research involving student. **Proposed.**

**Summer SURFers Program.** Intended to support faculty research that involves students, during the Summer. Students will participate in research and in a Summer SURFer Learning Community modeled on the IRLC.

Mini-Grant funding for up to four faculty research proposals that intentionally involve one to four students in faculty member's research project. Joint funding from Mini-Grant funds and SRSC funds.

- a) Mini-Grant funds support a faculty summer stipend.
- b) SRSC funding support up to 16 students.
